Due to an unexpected crack in the concrete on the launch ramp the forklift will be down for two days; Tuesday August 19th and Wednesday August 20th.

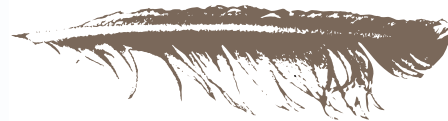
UPCOMING EVENTS
